AGNUS DEI: (Gathering) (sung) during the breaking of bread

1 *Jesus, Lamb of God, bread of life for us; Jesus, Lamb of God, wine of joy for us*

Chorus - Jesus, Lamb of God, bearing all our sin; Have mercy on us, Give us your peace.

2 *Jesus, Lamb of God, source of unity; Jesus, Lamb of God, precious cornerstone*

3 *Jesus, Lamb of God, bread that makes us one; Jesus, Lamb of God, wine that heals our pain.*

The Priest shows us the Blessed Sacrament and we respond:

Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,
