We kneel, the priest continues the prayer and then sings:

AGNUS DEI (sung): (Bratislava) during the breaking of bread

Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi, miserere nobis (x2)

Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi, dona nobis pacem,

dona nobis pacem, dona nobis pacem. (x2)

The Priest shows us the Blessed Sacrament and we respond:

Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,

but only say the word and my soul shall be healed
